## INFORMATION ABOUT THE HANDLING OF COVID-19 AT THE BOARDING SCHOOL

Dear boarding school students and parents,

I am writing to you further in connection with the letter sent from our Principal regarding COVID-19.

We are daily observant of our young people's welfare and health.

We are at the same time attentive in relation to the situation we are in with COVID-19 and follow the guidelines that the Danish authorities have defined.

At the same time, we also choose to intensify some of our rules and regulations as well as defining new rules in this area with the wish to minimize the risk of infection at the boarding school.

### We will daily intensify the rules that boarding school students already follow:

- Notification of illness must happen immediately to the boarding school team who are aware of symptoms etc.
- Show respect for others and stay in your room when you are ill. We wish to minimize the risk of infection in general.
- The boarding school teacher team will continuously follow-up on the students who are ill.
- It is expected that you disinfect your hands with spirit before you eat in the dining hall.
- That you continuously wash your hands and use the hand disinfection that you can find on all floors (in the passage by the bathrooms) and dining hall.
- On every day you are ill you MUST notify the boarding teacher team in the morning.

In the case of illness and the suspicion of COVID-19 we take our precautionary measures and contact the right specialists for the sake of each person and for everyone at the boarding school in order to prevent the possible spreading of infection.

In the case of a person being infected with COVID-19 the authorities will take over and we will follow their procedures in this area as well as passing on information to students and parents and others.

### Important - Travel activity

We expect boarding school students to follow the Danish authorities' recommendations in regard to travel.

In addition, we have set up the following rules:

ALL future travel to other countries MUST be approved by the undersigned. This includes pre-booked travel. It is expected that you contact the undersigned in good time and inform about future travel activities.

We cannot decide if you should travel but we do have the right to decide that a boarding school student cannot return to the boarding school before they have been in quarantine for 14 days.

### **Guests**

We are forced to make specific new rules for all guests at the boarding school.

You have joint responsibility not to bring a guest to the boarding school who has the risk of being a carrier of COVID-19. Be observant if they have been travelling and have possible symptoms.

All day guests must meet up at the teacher on duty on arrival.

Due to the situation we do not allow guests to stay overnight from the date today and in the future.

This rule will be changed when we decide it is possible to open again for overnight guests again.

It is expected that all the above rules must be followed. If the rules are not followed there will be consequences for your stay at the boarding school.

We will do our best, with common sense, to continue to make the boarding school a pleasant and safe place to be and remember you also play an important role as boarding school students and parents.
